### Fiscal Year 2010 Budget

The Fairfax County Board of Supervisors is considering strategies proposed in the County Executive's Fiscal Year 2010 Budget to address a budget shortfall of nearly \$650 million. Among the numerous strategies being considered is a proposal to reduce some Fairfax Connector bus service.

The County Executive did not propose an increase in Connector bus fares.

The Board of Supervisors will take comments from the public regarding all proposed budget cuts by phone, by Web, and at Public Hearings that will be held at the Fairfax County Government Center, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax, VA 22035 on:

- March 30 -- 7 p.m.
- March 31 -- 3 p.m.
- April 1 -- 3 p.m.

On April 27, 2009, the Board of Supervisors will approve the final budget for FY 2010.
