ROLLING ROAD RECONSTRUCTION BEGINS JUNE 17

Weekday lane closures necessary for upcoming road work

ALEXANDRIA, VA – Beginning Thursday, June 17, motorists on Rolling Road will experience occasional delays between the Fullerton Road intersection and Richfield Road while Virginia Department of Transportation and Federal Highway Administration crews reconstruct and repave a 1500-foot section of Rolling Road as part of the Fairfax County Parkway (Route 7100) project.

Motorists can expect intermittent lane closures between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., and 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Mondays through Fridays, and occasionally on Saturday and Sunday nights. A flagman will be on duty, and each day the lanes will be fully restored so both lanes will be open to traffic during rush hours. This work will continue until December 2010.
